

Professor Efim Zelmanov is the R. Atkinson Professor of Mathematics at University of California at San Diego, USA; the Scientific Director, International Center of Mathematics, SusTech, at Shenzhen, China and the Distinguished Professor at KIAS, Korea.

Professor Zelmanov made great contributions to the study of nonassociative algebras and group theory. He was awarded the Fields Medal at the International Congress of Mathematicians in 1994. He also got the College de France Medal in 1991.

Professor Zelmanov was elected a member of the National Academy of Science of the USA in 2001 and a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 1997. He became a Foreign Member of the Brazilian Academy of Sciences in 2012, a Foreign Member of the Academy of Sciences of Zaragoza in 2011, a Foreign Member of the Korean Academy of Science in 2008 and a Foreign Member of the Royal Academy of Spain in 2001.

Professor Zelmanov held positions at the Institute of Mathematics of the Academy of Sciences of the USSR in Novosibirsk, University of Wisconsin-Madison, University of Chicago and Yale University in the USA.
